<b>Termination for non-use</b>	If a prepaid mobile connection remains unused for 12 months, MTEL shall be entitled to block the mobile connection without prior notice. If the customer does not request reestablishment of the connection after a further 6 months, Sunrise shall be entitled to terminate the contract and to reclaim and reassign the corresponding number.
<b>Account balance</b>	The payout of prepaid credit is generally excluded. This also applies to credit transfers to another prepaid product. Exception: payout in the event of deactivation of the connection. There is no entitlement to payout on initial credit balances, top-up offers and bonus credit balances. The processing fee is CHF 30.00 per telephone number and will be deducted directly from the prepaid credit to be paid out.

	<p>Status of the prepaid card:</p> <p><u>Active</u> Last chargeable use within the past 547 days (18 months). It must be used for MTEL prepaid number to always remain active. Surf the mobile internet, make a call, send a text message or top up your credit.</p> <p><u>Deactivation</u> Last chargeable use more than 548 days (18 months). Sunrise shall be entitled to terminate the prepaid contract. The corresponding call number shall revert to Sunrise without compensation and be reassigned.</p>
<b>Prepaid change to another provider (number porting)</b>	A prepaid number can be ported to another network operator at any time. The remaining prepaid credit can be used until the number is ported and expires with the porting. Porting the number. Register by sending a text message the number 499 with the word YES.
<b>Ban on transferring the SIM</b>	If the prepaid SIM is transferred, the name and address of the initial purchaser will still be disclosed to the competent authorities at their request. If criminal acts are committed using the transferred prepaid SIM, the first purchaser may under certain circumstances be criminally prosecuted for aiding and abetting, complicity, or selective advantage.
