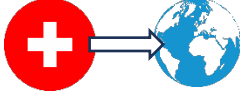

General tariff details	
Regular basic fee	CHF 35.00 including VAT
Campaigns / promotions / discounts / bonus / cashback	The campaigns, promotions, discounts, bonuses and cashbacks valid at the time of purchasing the tariff package apply.
Requirement	MTEL prepaid SIM card with sufficient credit at least in the amount of the basic fee to activate the tariff.
Tariff package term	The term is 14 days from activation. Example: activation on 12.04., 8:20 a.m. → ends on 26.04., 8:20 a.m. After expiry, the package automatically renews for a further 14 days, provided sufficient prepaid credit is available. If there is already an active package, a newly purchased package is only activated after expiry of the current package.
Extension / renewal	After consuming your high-speed data volume, you can book a new package. Activation takes place after the current package has expired or been used up. If there is sufficient credit, the tariff package renews automatically.
Activation	The tariff package is activated immediately after your order or activation, provided there is sufficient credit on your prepaid SIM card. If a valid package already exists, activation of the newly acquired package takes place automatically after expiry of the current tariff.
Inclusive units/credit	The units included are valid until expiry of the tariff package. Unused units expire at the end of the term and are not transferred.

Fair use information Usage information	The tariff is intended for personal use in Switzerland. Predominant use abroad or commercial use (e.g. in gateways/hotspots) is not permitted. If there are any indications of misuse, MTEL may take appropriate measures according to the special provisions.

Maximum speed (high-speed)	When LTE/4G+ and 5G/5G+ services are available, you benefit from speeds of up to 1.7 Gbit/s . The actual maximum speeds achieved depend on the number of simultaneously connected users as well as on the performance capacity of the device used, and <u>cannot be guaranteed</u> . Roaming Special and short numbers	Calls and SMS to special, premium, short and value-added service numbers abroad are blocked and are not possible. If any of these numbers can be called, the price is determined by the premium service provider of the number called.
Roaming Freephone numbers	Calls made in the country of stay to "freephone numbers" are charged at a higher tariff like special numbers and are not included in any inclusive call credits.
Standard roaming tariff Calls & SMS	<u>Roaming calls and SMS are activated by default when abroad.</u> If no inclusive units for calls and SMS are included in the corresponding tariff package, or if these have been used up and if no additional option is activated, calls & SMS are charged at the standard roaming tariff. The prices depend on the country of stay. Prices according to standard roaming tariffs motel.ch/de/p/m/roaming
Roaming calls from one zone to another zone	Outgoing calls between one zone and another zone are not included in the roaming MIN / SMS. Calls are billed according to the standard roaming tariffs.
Standard roaming tariff Internet	<u>Roaming data is deactivated by default when abroad.</u> If no inclusive units for data are included in the corresponding tariff package or if the inclusive units included have been used up, and if no additional option is activated, data ROAMING is deactivated at the standard tariff.
Standard roaming rates information	To reduce costs, your MTEL Team recommends activating roaming data packages. The usage-dependent prices depend on which country you are in.
Roaming via satellites	Roaming via satellite connections, e.g. in aeroplanes and cruise ships, is activated by default and is charged at higher tariffs.
Roaming voice mailbox	a) Calls from abroad to the voice mailbox to listen to voice messages are charged at the standard roaming tariff if the corresponding tariff package does not contain any inclusive units or if these have been used up and if no additional option has been activated. b) <u>Deactivate mailbox: #145# or activate mailbox: *145#</u>

Price adjustment	MTEL may adjust the price for each service once per calendar year in line with inflation. Inflation is calculated based on the national consumer price index (LIK) by the Federal Statistical Office (LIK basis December 2020 = 100 points). The status of the LIK on 1 January 2024 is taken as the starting index. If MTEL does not carry out a price adjustment for a service in a calendar year, this right shall not be forfeited in subsequent years. In the event of a price adjustment due to inflation, the customer is not entitled to terminate the service prematurely.
Termination for non-use	If a prepaid connection remains unused for 18 months, MTEL may suspend the connection; if it is not reactivated within a further 6 months, the prepaid connection may be terminated and the phone number reassigned.
Account balance	Regulations on prepaid credit and the status of the prepaid card As a general principle, prepaid credit can neither be paid out nor transferred to other products. An exception applies in the event of deactivation of the connection: in this case, the credit balance can be paid out, subject to the deduction of a processing fee of CHF 39.00 per number. It should be noted that starting credit, amounts from top-up promotions and bonus amounts are excluded from payouts. Status of the prepaid card <u>Active:</u> The prepaid card remains active provided that it has been used for a billable service within the last 548 days (18 months). This includes surfing the mobile internet, making a call, sending an SMS or topping up credit. <u>Deactivation:</u> If there is no billable use for more than 548 days (18 months), MTEL is entitled to terminate the prepaid connection.
Prepaid change to another provider (number porting)	A prepaid number can be transferred to another provider at any time. The remaining credit can be used until porting takes place, after which it expires. To port your number, send an SMS with "YES" to 499.
Ban on transferring the SIM	If the prepaid SIM is transferred, the name and address of the initial purchaser will still be disclosed to the competent authorities at their request. If criminal acts are committed using the transferred prepaid SIM, the first purchaser may under certain circumstances be criminally prosecuted for aiding and abetting, complicity, or selective advantage.
Other	In the event of civil disputes between the customer and telecommunications provider (value-added services, etc.), the arbitration board Ombudscom will mediate. More information is available at www.ombudscom.ch
